



## Deck Builder Expands Porch Design and Installation Services

All Pro Thornton Deck Builders has expanded its porch design and installation services, adding a wider selection of covered, screened, and wraparound structures for homeowners throughout Thornton, Colorado, and the neighboring communities of the north Denver metropolitan area. The broadened service line now guides projects from an initial design consultation through material selection, permitting, and final construction.

The expansion responds to sustained interest in shaded, weather-protected outdoor living areas, which have become a common priority for property owners seeking to extend usable space beyond interior walls. Porches built for the region must account for intense summer sun, wide seasonal temperature swings, and occasional heavy snowfall, factors that shape roofing choices, framing, and drainage. The updated service addresses these conditions during the design phase rather than after installation begins.

"The expansion reflects a steady rise in requests for shaded, weather-protected outdoor rooms that remain usable through most of the year," said David Miller, owner of All Pro Thornton Deck Builders. Miller added that combining design and construction under one crew allows a project to proceed as a continuous process,

reducing the handoffs that can delay completion.

The expanded service covers several porch types, including open front porches, fully covered structures, screened enclosures that limit insects and debris, and wraparound designs that follow more than one side of a residence. Each project begins with a site assessment that reviews the existing structure, lot orientation, and load requirements before a design is finalized. Material options range from pressure-treated lumber and cedar to composite decking and aluminum or steel framing, chosen according to budget, maintenance preferences, and exposure.

During the design phase, plans account for how a porch will connect to existing rooflines, entry points, and grade, so that the finished structure aligns with the home rather than appearing as a separate addition. Sizing decisions weigh the intended use, whether for dining, seating, or simple shelter at an entrance, against setback rules and available lot space. Porch framing in snow-prone areas also carries load considerations that differ from those for an open deck, which the design review takes into account before framing is ordered.

Installation follows local building codes and, where required, coordinates permitting with municipal authorities before construction proceeds. A typical porch project moves through design approval, material ordering, foundation or ledger work, framing, roofing, and finishing, with timelines shaped by scope, weather, and inspection schedules. Clients receive a defined plan at the outset that sets expectations for each stage of the build.

The company covers Thornton and adjacent Adams County communities, and coordinates each project with the schedules and inspection requirements that apply in the relevant jurisdiction. Screened and covered options in particular have drawn interest from households looking to use outdoor space across a longer portion of the year, given the region's mix of strong sun and cold winter months. Maintenance guidance is provided at handover so that owners understand the care each material requires over time.

Outdoor construction of this kind has drawn increased attention as remodeling budgets shift toward projects that enlarge functional living space and add shaded gathering areas. A properly built porch can also provide a covered transition between yard and interior, protecting entryways from weather and limiting direct heat on adjacent rooms. These practical results, rather than any single decorative feature, tend to drive the requests the company now handles through its porch design services.

The broadened offering keeps design, engineering, and installation within a single team based in the Thornton area, which the company states helps maintain consistent standards from the first drawing to the final inspection. David Miller noted that a coordinated approach also gives homeowners a single point of accountability, since the group that plans a porch is the same group that constructs it.
